



How to check if you may be able to get Kyleena[®], Mirena[®], or Skyla[®] intrauterine device (IUD) with no out-of-pocket costs*

Follow these easy steps to check:

- Step 1. Call the number on the back of your insurance card.
- Step 2. Tell them that Mirena[®], Kyleena[®], or Skyla[®] is a healthcare provider-administered prescription.
- Step 3. Ask them to check if Mirena, Kyleena, or Skyla is covered at no cost* under the Affordable Care Act.
- Step 4. Provide them with the J code for the IUD you will be receiving:
Mirena: J7298 | Kyleena: J7296 | Skyla: J7301
- Step 5. Ask if you will have any out-of-pocket costs if Mirena, Kyleena, or Skyla is only partially covered under your plan.
